The hope is to move the offices into the front of the house and also have my office and bedroom fixed up so that I could work and live there.

I have a three-part-plan for the Parish:

- 1 – Make the Old Rectory a Renewed Rectory-to work and live there.
  - 2 – Work with school with the possibility of using the old Convent as a Pre-school.
  - 3 – Make a list of areas especially in and around the Church that need some touching up or repairs.
